

Way back in 1999, we approached the children at the Spastics Society of Karnataka (SSK) to design our visual identity. Children with cerebral palsy are often blessed with fine minds that are trapped in a disobedient body. Yet, they have brave, creative minds and some of them are extremely gifted artists.

LTIMindtree leadership team stood in front of ten young students of the SSK and gave a brief about LTIMindtree brand. Some of the students were in wheelchairs, some had to be carried and some barely managed to stand on their unwilling legs. But they listened with magical spark in their eyes. These children, boys and girls between ages of 13 to 20, understood our Mission, our Vision and our Core Values.

Two weeks after the first meeting with our young friends, we were flooded with several possible options. The one that clearly stood out was the work of 17-year-old K. S. Chetan. Chetan has a form of cerebral palsy that denies him coordinated limb movement and affects his speech. But his brilliant mind overcame all odds. In one skyward blue brush stroke, Chetan depicted boundless imagination. He surrounded the skyward blue brush stroke with yellow dots, pretty much like a tree in bloom. To him, the yellow dots symbolized "bubbles of joy".

Today, LTIMindtree Foundation takes the story forward and is the custodian of the logo.







Prashit says, "Science is a challenging subject, and there are times when I don't understand the meaning of certain words. Agastya has helped me understand the basics of science, and I feel comfortable asking questions with my instructors."

Working in teams during Agastya sessions has been a positive experience for him. He states, "I feel very good working in a team because, in a team, each of us gets a chance to experiment one by one. I learned how plasma models work, such as the presence of neon gas, and in computer sessions, I understood why we don't use CPUs but instead work with Raspberry kits. It's all fascinating. Agastya sessions have been incredibly helpful."



Today, those once-determined students have transformed into accomplished doctors. They have successfully completed their BSC in physiotherapy. 

Story of Transformation Deepak, Hyderabad, Placed with Horizon Solutions as Hardware Network Engineer



Hailing from Banaswada, Deepak's life took a tumultuous turn after his father's untimely death. Left to navigate financial hardships alongside his mother and grandparents, Deepak's dreams of pursuing higher education seemed shattered.

Despite facing challenges, Deepak found the Certificate Program in Information Technology (CPIT) offered by Edunet (partnered with the LTIMindtree Foundation) to be a viable alternative for pursuing his dreams. Initially aspiring to be an electrical engineer, he discovered CPIT's ITeS program covering networking, hardware, software, and computer skills to be a refreshing curriculum compared to conventional education. Deepak appreciated the innovative and practical teaching methods and expressed his enthusiasm for the program by stating, "This is the right way to learn new skills."

Today, Deepak embarks on a new chapter after landing a networking technician role through the CPIT program. He credits his success to the interview training provided by the program, stating it was crucial in securing his new position.

Story of Transformation You don't need expensive degrees to excel in life!

Vijaylaxmi was born into a farming family in Malgundi village. After 10th grade, she could not afford to study and was convinced that she cannot find any job in this competitive world.

Then came the CPIT program—an opportunity Vijaylaxmi initially viewed as a chance to gain basic computer literacy and a stipend. However, once she joined the program, she discovered that it offered not only relevant tech skills but also the flexibility to choose between topics of her interest, such as ITeS and full-stack development tracks. Intrigued by the hardware aspect of technology, she dived into the ITeS track. "I had no idea how interviews work. We were taught from scratch and were prepared to face professional environments and situations," she says. Vijaylaxmi felt confident in her job interviews. She has now landed a job in hardware, a field she has grown fond of during the program.

Vijaylaxmi stated, "CPIT shattered the belief that expensive degrees are the only path to professional success. It provided me with a rare opportunity to excel despite dropping out of 10th grade. I want to make the most of it now."

We empower persons with disabilities (PwD) across India through our comprehensive project, Disability Interventions. This initiative encompasses a range of interventions aimed at providing holistic support and opportunities for PwD.

Through our healthcare, education, therapy, livelihood, and social security programs, we strive to enhance the quality of life and promote inclusivity for PwD. Our focus extends beyond mere assistance and encompasses rehabilitation, enabling individuals to lead independent and fulfilling lives.

As a part of our Disability Interventions initiative, we engage in various activities that cater to the diverse needs of the PwD community. This includes building inclusive parks and creating accessible spaces that foster recreation and social interaction for individuals with disabilities. Story of Transformation All-Inclusive Sensory Park!



Ananda Mela is an all-inclusive sensory park built as a CSR initiative by LTIMindtree. Local communities have praised the park, calling it one of the best they've encountered. It's not just a playground; it's a place where fun meets therapy. Information boards explain how each piece of equipment can aid in a child's development. The vibrant colors and abundant shade trees create a joyful and welcoming atmosphere. The park is divided into three zones: a sensory play area, an inclusive play area, and an open amphitheater. It also has a special swing for people in wheelchairs. One need not get out of the wheelchair; the wheelchair can go in, and one can swing normally. Other educational tools like abacuses and charts are available in Braille for the visually impaired.

"There was a need for people with disabilities to have a space of their own. There were no gardens or play areas available to them. After sharing our idea, we were allotted an acre at Cubbon Park, a state-run park in Bangalore. The project turned out very well, so we decided to create similar parks in other cities as well." - Paneesh Rao, Chief Sustainability Officer at LTIMindtree.

India achieved its best-ever performance, winning 17 medals and finishing 6th on the medal table at the 2024 World Para Athletics Championships in Kobe, Japan. We contributed our CSR initiatives towards the training of ten para athletes supported by OGQ, a sports-focused NGO co-founded by Geet Sethi and Prakash Padukone in 2001.

We are happy to announce that OGQ supported 13 of India's 17 medal winners and four of its six gold medal winners. OGQ provides coaching, sports equipment, nutrition, psychological support, and injury management to help Indian athletes achieve their dreams.

34-year-old Sachin Khilari hails from Karagani village in Maharashtra's Sangli district. He suffered a mishap during his school days, leading to disability in his left hand. It was a proud moment to witness Sachin set a new Para Asian Record in the Men's Shot Put F46 Finals with the best throw of 16.30 meters.

To add to the happiness, Mariyappan Thangavelu, the 2X Paralympic medalist, became the World Champion in Men's High Jump T42. OCG supported Mariyappan's training, and Field Coach Jeremy Fischer greatly helped him win the championship title. Congratulations to all Paralympic champions!

Our initiative transformed the life of Smt. P. Nagamani, a 49-year-old woman. Nagamani's journey is a testament to resilience and the power of opportunity. In 2005, she faced a devastating blow when she unexpectedly lost her husband. Suddenly, she found herself as the sole provider for her two children, a daunting responsibility she shouldered.

Nagamani turned to Kalamkari artistry, a traditional Indian art form, to make ends meet. For fifteen years, she toiled as a Kalamkari laborer. However, her earnings barely reached Rs.4,000 per month. This small income was insufficient to cover their expenses, leaving Nagamani constantly worried about their future.

Everything changed when Nagamani joined the Sri Padmavathy Women's Cooperative, which was part of the Women Artisans Project.

The project aims to empower women artisans by providing them with the skills and resources needed to become successful entrepreneurs. Nagamani embraced this opportunity wholeheartedly. She attended design classes that not only honed her existing skills but also introduced her to new techniques and trends in the world of Kalamkari.

With newfound confidence, Nagamani launched her own business. The Women Artisans Project provided her with the necessary raw materials, enabling her to create stunning Kalamkari dupattas and sarees. Her dedication and artistic talent quickly began to shine through her work. What was once a struggle to make ends meet transformed into a flourishing business. Today, Nagamani earns up to Rs.10,000 per month.

The Women Artisans Project's success lies in its holistic approach. It doesn't merely provide training but also provides continuous support and access to markets, enabling these women to thrive. This initiative has created a ripple effect in their communities, inspiring other women to embrace entrepreneurship and self-reliance.

Smt. P. Nagamani's transformation from a struggling laborer to a successful businesswoman underscores the profound impact of the Women Artisans Project. This initiative is changing lives, one artisan at a time.

Story of Transformation Weaving Dreams



Smt. B. Latha is a weaver from Bangaru Peta Village of Kalahasthi Rural Mandal. She comes from a family of weavers. She received initial training in weaving from her parents. She got married to Mr. Tarak, who also comes from a family of weavers, and they have two children who are studying in the local school.

Despite her husband's weaving work, their family still faced financial difficulties and could not cover all their expenses. To address this, Smt. B. Latha started working as a daily laborer in Kalamkari saree making. Through training provided by the Sri Padmavathy Women Mutually Aided Cooperative Consumers Stores (SPCCS) as part of the Women Artisans Project, she gained the skills to start her own business and become an entrepreneur.

She used to earn Rs. 5,000, and now she is earning up to Rs. 10,000 per month. Her future aspiration is to grow her business by acquiring more orders and providing work to other women from her community and helping them earn a livelihood.



Story of Transformation Our Community Development Officers Are Good Social Motivators





Our Community Development Officers noticed that many women in villages lack the motivation to pursue their dreams due to limited options for sustainable livelihood. As a result, they have fewer opportunities and less hope for their future. However, these women have great potential.

In a group meeting in Kalaburagi district, Aland block, Bhangarag village, Mr. Vithal, Mr. Somu, and M. Jaibhim, our Community Development Officers, encouraged Didi to consider goat rearing as a means of livelihood.

They explained how goat rearing can help increase income. Today, inspired by Didi, a small group including Laxmi Dharmaraya, Lalita Basavaraj, Laxmi Ashok, and Mallamma Sunil meet regularly to train and support each other. Have purchased goats for rearing and are diligently caring for them. We are confident that this project will have a positive impact on other women in the community.



Story of Transformation A New Dawn in Chinchansoor

Chinchansoor village is located in the Aland block of Kalaburagi district, about 25 kilometers away from the city. Every March, the village holds a grand fair in honor of its presiding deity, Maragamma Devi. During this fair, villagers open temporary shops to earn some extra income.

The representatives of The/Nudge Institute visited Chinchansoor village and spoke with the Panchayat members. During the PAT survey, the Institute observed that many people in the village live in extreme poverty.

Vidyavathi and her husband Annappa reside in Chinchansoor village. When our representatives initiated a conversation with the village's Panchayat members, they learned about Vidyavathi's struggles.

Vidyavathi suffers from a spine injury. Doctors have advised her to rest and she is confined to her home. She used to work as a housekeeper and laborer, but due to her surgery, she can no longer work. Both their children attend school, and the family is burdened with hospital expenses. With both husband and wife unable to work, the family struggles to make ends meet.

Community Development Officer Mahesh was in constant touch with the family and remembered Vidyavati's statement that she had experience running a small business earlier.



The/Nudge Institute selected Vidyavati for the End Ultra Poverty program and provided her with a grocery shop as part of her first livelihood. Vidyavati and her family did the work with great interest.

Vidyavati has now opened a grocery store. She was the first independent woman to open the a grocery store in her area. The/Nudge Institute, with support from LTIMindtree Foundation, deposited a total of Rs. 15,000 into Vidyavati's bank account.

Vidyawati bought groceries from Kalaburagi market for a total of Rs. 12800. Initially, the grocery store earned Rs. 600 to Rs. 700 per day, so the minimum profit was an average of Rs. 200 per day. Vidyavati's family has found new courage and hope in life.



Story of Transformation

PCB course by Y4d Foundation and LTIMindtree Team



Jayshree Nehe is from Savargaon Tal village in Sangamner Taluka, Ahmednagar. Her village, nestled amidst hills, experiences abundant rainfall during the monsoon season yet faces challenges with drinking water scarcity in the summers. As the primary livelihood is seasonal paddy cultivation during the monsoon, her community is unemployed for seven to eight months annually.

After completing 12th grade, Jayshree and her mother became manual laborers to support their family because of her father's illness.

Jayshree enrolled in the PCB course offered by the Y4d Foundation, which provided free training, accommodation, and meals. Jayashree states that this course was a ray of hope for her.

Through the course, Jayshree acquired electronics soldering, and financial management skills. This led to a job as an Assistant Operator at Marsh with a monthly salary of Rs. 14,500. Though she was initially hesitant about long working hours, she began to enjoy the job and was motivated to support her family. She saves Rs. 10,000 per month, and her family is happy knowing she is financially secure.

Jayshree stated, "I am immensely grateful to the Y4d Foundation and LTIMindtree team for extending their support and enabling me to be independent. Their assistance has not only transformed my life but has also empowered me to support my family during challenging times."

Story of Transformation From Struggle to Stability



Meet Uppari Mounika from Thurkapalli village in Medak District. After completing intermediate education, Uppari had to get employed due to financial challenges at home. She decided to enroll in the PCB Assembly Operator course at the Hyderabad center, facilitated by the Y4D Foundation in association with LTIMindtree.

After completing the course, she secured a position at Jayabheri Nexa with a monthly salary of Rs.16,000 per month. She is delighted to contribute Rs.7,000 to her family every month. Today, she is thrilled to share that she has emerged from a difficult period in life victoriously and is now enjoying financial stability and happiness. She says, "I would like to express my gratitude to the entire Y4D Foundation and LTIMindtree team for their support. I thank you for being a beacon of hope and a catalyst for positive change in my life."



Story of Transformation Providing Fuel Security to Communities While Making Kitchens Climate-Smart, One Eco-Chullha at a Time!



During a routine visit to Sayale village, Ms. Ruchi Bhadake, AERF's Project lead for eco-chullhas, witnessed a heartwarming scene. The lady of the house, Mrs. Shital Suresh Maeen, was cooking for her family on the eco-chullha. Warmly inviting Ruchi and her team inside, Shital insisted they stay for lunch. As she prepared Bhakaris on the eco-chullha, she began sharing her experience with the innovative stove.

"I am a working woman," Shital explained, her hands skillfully flipping the bread. "I work at the local village hospital, and this eco-chullha saves me so much time each day. Everything cooks so quickly with minimal preparation! Our fuel consumption has also significantly decreased. We don't like cutting down trees for firewood, but until now, we had no viable alternative. LPG doesn't suit all our cooking methods and is expensive. This eco-chullha is the most convenient option, and I don't have to change how I cook or learn anything new to operate it."



Shital's story is a testament to the high adoption rates of eco-chullhas among local communities. AERF's success lies in its evidence-based approach, ensuring that the eco-chullhas offer real advantages over existing technologies. These stoves are compatible with traditional culinary practices and easy to understand and use, blending seamlessly into the daily lives of rural families without compromising their traditions. Since switching to the eco-chullha, Shital hasn't refilled her LPG cylinder in three months.

As she continued, Shital pointed to the blackened walls of her kitchen. "You see these walls? They're black from the smoke generated by our old chullah. Now, there's virtually no smoke. My eyes no longer burn, my wheezing has reduced, and I feel happy cooking on the eco-chullha. This Diwali, I think I'll repaint my kitchen. I don't think the walls will go black anytime soon." She offered the team another Bhakari, which they eagerly accepted. The bread had a delightful smoky flavor. "You won't find that taste in a Bhakari cooked on an LPG stove. Enjoy it."

AERF's thoughtful distribution of 3,023 eco-chullhas in the Sangameshwar, Mandangad, and Alibaug blocks has profoundly impacted these communities.

Mrs. Shital Maeen's story is just one of many that underscores the profound impact of the eco-chullha project, illustrating how simple yet thoughtful innovations can transform lives, making everyday tasks easier and more sustainable while preserving cherished traditions.



By protecting and restoring mangroves, we enhance the resilience of coastal communities, helping them adapt to the challenges posed by climate change.





Our project emphasizes the importance of creating incentives for local communities to safeguard mangrove forests. We work closely with these communities, engaging them in sustainable practices and providing them with the necessary resources to protect and conserve mangroves. Through awareness programs and capacity building, we develop a sense of ownership and responsibility among the local stakeholders, fostering long-term sustainability.

Mangroves are known for their exceptional capacity to sequester carbon, making them a crucial component of blue-carbon ecosystems. By preserving and restoring mangrove forests, we contribute to mitigating climate change by capturing and storing significant amounts of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. This helps to offset carbon emissions and combat the adverse effects of global warming.



Story of Transformation From Timber to Treasures: Communities Embrace Forest Conservation With AERF

In March 2023, AERF held a community meeting in several villages to discuss the 'Conservation Agreement' approach and gauge the willingness of the locals to bring their forests under our conservation management. We were delighted by the responses we received.

"After we abandoned cultivation, we used to sell timber to the logging contractors. The last time, I received almost two lakhs, but I was not happy. Even while accepting the money, I felt guilty because I knew the logging contractor made huge profits from my forest. But my family needed the money. However, with AERF's conservation agreement approach, we can finally do away with the guilt and listen to our conscience! Rajesh Jadhav, AERF's community expert in Sangameshwar, explained the process and documents so clearly and transparently. This is the first program offering us incentives while retaining ownership of our forest land. We will definitely support AERF in any way we can." stated Mr. Anil Ghagare from Tirawade Tarf Saundal village.

Mr. Vishwas Patil from Nerle village added his perspective. "People think we do not understand deforestation and climate change, but we know it very well because we live it firsthand! We understand the impact when a water channel dries up due to deforestation on the higher slopes. We notice even the smallest increase in temperature when a patch of protective trees is cleared. However, we had no livelihood opportunities from these forests and were forced to give in to logging companies' demands to sustain our families. Now, with AERF's conservation agreements, we can protect our forests and explore innovative ways to generate income. I remember my grandparents collecting fruits and seeds from these forests and selling them locally. I'm glad that your 'sustainable value chain' approach will help us restore those practices and earn money."





In May 2023, AERF successfully signed a Conservation Agreement for 200 acres in Tirawade Tarf Saundal and Nerle villages.

AERF quoted, "We are grateful to partner with LTIMindtree, who shares our beliefs and has supported the conservation of forests at these sites. Together, we are empowering communities to make choices that align with their conscience and contribute to sustainable, long-lasting environmental stewardship."

Our project is driven by the goal of increasing farmer incomes, ensuring environmental protection, and achieving carbon neutrality through various carbon sequestration activities.

Tree-tings focuses on implementing tree plantation initiatives, protecting forests and ecosystems, and supporting rural livelihoods for sustainable development. By integrating trees into farmlands, we enhance biodiversity, improve soil health, and mitigate the impact of climate change. Through our project, we actively promote the adoption of sustainable agricultural practices that reduce reliance on chemical inputs and foster a more environmentally friendly approach to farming.

At the core of Tree-tings is the belief that sustainable agriculture benefits farmers and contributes to the preservation of our environment. By increasing farmer incomes through sustainable practices, we empower local communities and promote economic growth. Furthermore, the carbon sequestration activities implemented through our project play a vital role in mitigating greenhouse gas emissions, contributing to our collective efforts towards achieving carbon neutrality.



Story of Transformation Sowing Seeds of Change: Farmers Lead the Agroforestry Revolution in Upponka Village

Mr. Venkatesh, a farmer in Upponka Village, Kalyandurgam, stands as a testament to the grit and resilience of resident farm households. This town, officially formed during the colonial period in the late 1800s, has witnessed countless tales of generational conflict, more than its social records could acknowledge.

Venkatesh faced a dilemma: choosing between natural farming and conventional methods that abuse the land. However, inspired by the agroforestry movement, he began transitioning to sustainable practices. His efforts have not only transformed his farmland but also inspired others in the community to adopt agroforestry principles. This influence from small-holding farmers to prominent landowners and villagers occurs when the benefits of change become too visible to ignore. Agroforestry models, facilitated by organizations like SayTrees and supported by LTIMindtree, harness this complex cycle of influence within communities facing generational income insecurity and crop failures.

"I started small with natural farming," shared Mahadevappa, a farmer from Appilepalli. "I was skeptical if it would be effective, given the scarcity of essential resources like water in our region. I doubted whether the saplings would survive, but now I am glad I went the SayTrees way; #Agroforestry has potential."







Mahadevappa is one of 22 farmers collaborating with SayTrees and LTIMindtree on a landscape model covering around 100 acres of land. Consistent with natural farming practices like applying Jeevamrutham, mulching, and using botanical extracts, he diligently reviewed the effectiveness of these methods. Despite having no additional irrigation support systems on his rainfed farm, Mahadevappa's conviction and honesty in his approach were admirable. The techniques he learned in on-ground farmer learning sessions enabled him to optimize his existing farm resources effectively.

"Our role is to support and stand by farmers as they transition to the Agroforestry system," stated Homendra, an on-ground technical expert. "Only farmers can make the magic happen in our model because we consciously promote farmer agency." Working with farmers means not just responding to government systems and aids designed for them but also integrating these supports meaningfully. The intervention does not isolate farmers from existing structures; instead, it intertwines them, keeping farm productivity as the reference point. For instance, under the well-known MGNREGA scheme, 22 farmers from Ananthapuramu created contour trenches to harvest water for their farmlands this summer, providing much-needed relief during the off-season cash crunch.

Through these efforts, farmers like Mr. Venkatesh and Mahadevappa are making significant strides towards sustainable farming. They are proving that with the right support and determination, traditional agricultural practices can evolve to meet modern challenges while preserving the integrity of the land.

These credits can then be traded or used to compensate for carbon emissions in other sectors, fostering a sustainable and low-carbon economy.





One of our primary activities is the construction of farm ponds for rainwater harvesting and irrigation. These ponds serve as reservoirs for capturing and storing rainwater, ensuring its availability during dry periods. By utilizing this stored water for irrigation, farmers can maintain consistent crop growth, even in the absence of regular rainfall. This reduces their dependency on erratic weather patterns and enhances their resilience against droughts.

In addition to rainwater harvesting, the project focuses on implementing soil and water conservation measures. These measures aim to reduce erosion and increase groundwater recharge, ensuring the long-term sustainability of water resources. By employing techniques such as contour plowing, terracing, and bunding, we minimize soil erosion, retain moisture in the soil, and promote groundwater recharge. This leads to improved soil fertility, enhanced crop yields, and the preservation of valuable water resources.

The Water Conservation Project also recognizes the importance of agroforestry in promoting stable incomes and sustainable land management. We create a diverse and resilient farming system by integrating trees and shrubs with crops. Agroforestry provides multiple benefits, including improved soil health, increased biodiversity, and additional income streams through the sale of timber, fruits, and other forest products. This approach not only enhances agricultural productivity but also contributes to climate change mitigation and the restoration of degraded landscapes.



Story of Transformation A Tomato Revolution: Kumar's Path to Prosperity



In the picturesque Hadya Village of Mysore District, Mr. Kumar had long toiled on his one-acre farm, cultivating tomatoes year after year. With profits stagnant at Rs. 20,000-25,000 annually, Kumar sought a breakthrough. His turning point came in November 2023 when he approached the National Agro Foundation (NAF), which had partnered with LTIMindtree to revolutionize tomato farming.

NAF provided modern agricultural training and conducted thorough soil testing of his land. Based on the results, they prescribed a tailored mix of borax, magnesium sulfate, ferrous sulfate, and essential micronutrients. Kumar embraced their guidance wholeheartedly, adding prophylactic pest control measures to his arsenal.



In a bid to test these innovations, Kumar split his farm into two: one plot following traditional methods and the other adhering to NAF's modern techniques. The difference was startling. On the NAF-recommended plot, Kumar harvested an impressive 6,666.6 kg of tomatoes, compared to 6,400 kg from the traditional plot.

Selling his bountiful yield at Rs. 1,500 per ton, Kumar reaped a profit of Rs. 50,000 from the innovative plot, dwarfing the Rs. 15,760 earned from his conventional methods. This remarkable success showcased the power of NAF's expertise and support.



Buoyed by this triumph, Kumar is now a staunch advocate for modern agricultural practices. Grateful to NAF and LTIMindtree for their invaluable assistance, he plans to continue implementing these methods and urges his fellow farmers to embrace change for greater prosperity.
