The client is a leading university based in Saudi Arabia.



The client wanted to ensure availability and accessibility to new 11 e-services via a portal and one window operation for multiple tasks for Students and Faculty/Staff in the university. Integration of the client's back-end systems and ERP to give a seamless data integration on Enterprise Service Bus and reusability of the standard services through REST/SOAP services was also on the cards.

The client also wanted to:

- > Re-engineer & optimize the business processes to meet the customer's needs & frequent changes in user requirements.
- > Implement Application Development Framework User Interface customizations for better user experience and support responsiveness on handheld devices.
